We are approaching the halfway point of our in-shop work on this 2205 Stainless fabrication and modularization project.

This Project will ultimately be installed atop two Absorber Modules at a power plant.

Our shop fabrication began in March of 2011 and will be completed in July 2011, at which time our dock side crews will begin the final assembly process at our barging facility prior to loading the various large modularized components onto our delivery barges.
