By the end of November we had completed 50% of the fabrication on one of our baghouse projects we have underway. On the eight module Pulse Jet Fabric Filter System, we have shipped over 400 tons of fabricated material to our deep water port in Rogers City. At the dock, the modules will be connected and test fit, and then prepared for barge loading for shipment to the end customer's plant.
